Domestic Abuse can happen to anyone in any relationship within a domestic setting. It can happen within family setting or can take place within extended family relationship. It also refers to abuse which continues from relationships once you have left the domestic setting.

Domestic abuse may take place in many different forms, it may be:

- sexual abuse
- physical abuse
- verbal abuse
- mental/emotional abuse
- financial abuse (withholding you from money)
- isolation; not allowed out to see friends or family
- controlling partner or family
- being insulted, depressed, degraded etc
